## Key Vocabulary:

<b>Local</b>	Includes the area we live in.
<b>Map</b>	A representation of an area of land or sea showing features.
<b>Fieldwork</b>	Practical work conducted by researchers.
<b>Area</b>	Part of town or place in a neighbourhood.
<b>Animal</b>	A living creature.
<b>Environment</b>	Everything around us, including living and non-living things.
<b>Survey</b>	Look closely at or examine something.
<b>Wildlife</b>	The native animals and plants of an area.
<b>Human features</b>	Features that are made by humans e.g. buildings.
<b>Physical features</b>	Features that naturally occur e.g. mountains and forests.
