

IF YOU WERE AN ENGINEER WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

Fynamore School has registered to be part of an exciting competition run by Primary Engineer Leaders Award.

The aim of the competition (open to 3-19 years) is to give children the opportunity 'to extend their understanding of stem careers and their place in modern life'.

The children will be expected to:

- Interview an engineer to find out about their work.**
- Think about a problem in everyday life that needs solving.**
- Research and plan a solution to the problem.**
- Draw and annotate their solution onto A4 or A3 paper.**
- Write a letter (on one side of A4) to the engineers that will judge their design. The letter should explain where their idea came from/who inspired them and how it works.**
- Only individual entries with a completed pupil form will be accepted.**

If your child would like to enter the competition, the closing date is March 27th. To enable us to compile any entries we would need them in school by March 25th.
