Year 6 – World War One day at Kingsbury Green Academy

Kingsbury Green Academy are holding a day of exciting activities with a theme of World War One on Tuesday, 24 September.

There will be a variety of lessons that bring World War One to life in a fun way whilst helping the children understand the reality and historical context of the War. Students will look at the poems of the War poets, immersing themselves in the trenches and creating their own poetry. They will record poems and add battle sounds to their recordings.

They will read reminiscences of men who fought in the trenches and bring their experiences to life in Drama. They will also look at the Historical context of the War and understand what it was like for those that were left at home as well as those who went off to fight.

The children will need to attend in their school uniform, bring a pencil case, a packed lunch and a drink with them. Please note, any lunches that have been booked and paid for on this day will be cancelled and credited.
